Most recently, to commemorate Michael's 80th birthday in March 2022 his son, Andrew hired a professional recording studio and invited all the former band members from over the past forty years for a reunion session.

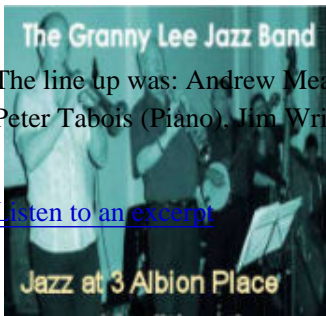
